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Summary of Institution Mission and Student Achievement

The mission of the American Denturist College is to provide an outstanding education through distance learning. We aim to equip students with the academic and technical skills needed for immediate success in the workforce, further education, and lifelong learning.

The American Denturist College evaluates student achievement by monitoring performance measures, which include graduation rate, student academic progress, and State Licensure rates for graduates.

Aggregated Institutional Data on Student Achievement

The American Denturist College's diploma program is offered in a 1, 2, & 3 year program lengths. A student has up to 4.5 years to complete the program.

For cohorts 1/7/2013-7/6/2020, we had a total of 105 students enroll. 21 of those students left the program prematurely and 68 have graduated. Our Graduation rate for cohorts 1/7/2013-7/6/2020 is 78%.

Of those 68 Graduates, 58 (84.74%) have received Denturist Licensure in their respective States.

Student academic progress for the last completed term (Fall 2024), 97.64% of 44 didactic students passed with 70% or above.

The American Denturist College's Bachelors Completion Degree in Denturism is offered in a 1 lengths. A student has up to 1.5 years to complete the program.

For cohorts 2020-2024, we had a total of 7 students enroll. 0 of those students left the program prematurely and 6 have graduated. Our Graduation rate for cohorts 2020-2024 is 100%.

Student academic progress for the last completed term (Fall 2024), 100% of 2 didactic students passed with 70% or above.
